

OSUN Work-Away: Staff Mobility Program

Application Checklist

The Open Society University Network (OSUN) staff mobility pilot program "OSUN Work-Away" provides opportunities for staff to spend up to one month embedded at a partner institution to learn about its administrative processes and contribute to cross-institutional integration. Details are provided in the current <u>call for applications</u>.

Applications should be submitted through the <u>OSUN Portal</u> before the **October 13, 2023** deadline.

You may use the outline below to prepare your answers and then cut-and-paste them into the online application. The following documents must be submitted with your application:

- 1. Resume or curriculum vitae
- 2. A support letter from your office director
- 3. An additional professional reference letter from a current or former supervisor or colleague that attests to your relevant qualifications (see the Selection Criteria in the Call for Applications)
- 4. Host partner letter signed by the relevant office director or institution official, if a host partner is already identified, which briefly explains (a) how the host will integrate you during your stay and (b) what the host institution expects of you

Final approval of staff mobility placements is contingent upon the host institution's approval and confirmation of the placement dates and the scope of work.

The review of applications for staff mobility is competitive. OSUN will consider only those proposals that best meet its priorities.

- 11. Please detail any prior experience living abroad, including where you lived, how long you were there, what months and years you were abroad, and what you were doing.

 You don't need to list vacations or short trips. (2,000 characters with spaces maximum)
